There is ample parking in the hotel garage or if you are planning to come in the night before the hotel will provide you with a parking key to the hotel parking lot.

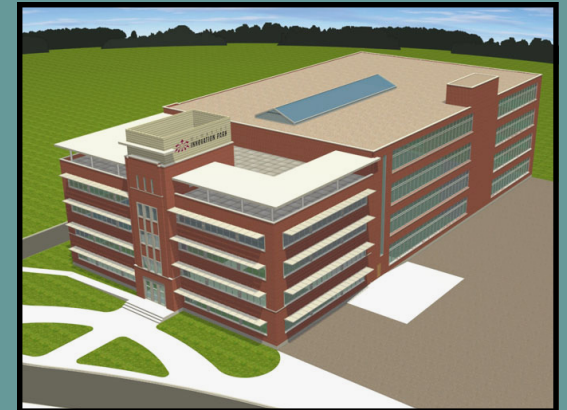

Facilities for the Future

Today facilities are commonly viewed as seats in a rectangular box called a classroom, in a building that is interconnected by hallways.

To envision building and operating schools for the next ten years it may be necessary to rethink the vision that stems from the shape of schools that has evolved over the last 100 years.

Technology, and the way that people are using it, is casting doubt on the validity of designing and building schools in the traditional way.

Without insights into the direction that technology is developing, it is likely that the new schools we envision building today, and two years from now, will be obsolete before they are occupied three years from now.

Facilities development for the next decade will require a rethinking of how learning takes place.

School boards of today seldom can be found with sufficient expertise to guide facility development in ways that meet tomorrow's needs.

Future success in school facility development requires that leaders learn how to maximize the life-span of today's infrastructure projects by designing them for the world tomorrow.

Trailblazer 4 is designed to enable school administrators to gain insight into emerging trends so as to enable more forward looking vision of school development.
