The Louisiana School Boards Association's "LOUISIANA BELIEVES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS!" video contest will award three \$2500 prizes to the schools or districts that produce the top three videos.

**VIDEO REQUIREMENTS:** The video must be between 30 seconds to 2 minutes long. (At least 30 seconds, but no longer than 2 minutes.) The following theme must guide the student-produced videos: "The Arts are a Powerful Way to Learn in Public Schools."

**VIDEO JUDGING:** A panel of independent judges made up of media professionals will determine the top three videos submitted to the LSBA's statewide competition.

**SUBMITTING YOUR VIDEO:** Video DVD format submissions ONLY of final product to LSBA. **Entries must be postmarked by Monday, January 9, 2017** and sent to: LSBA Video Contest, Attention: Janet Pope, 7912 Summa Ave, Baton Rouge, LA 70809. **CONTEST PRIZES:** The top three (3) winning schools or school districts will each be awarded \$2,500. The winners will be announced and showcased at the February 2017 LSBA Annual State Convention in New Orleans, Louisiana. The prize money will be awarded to the schools/school districts/school board members and system leadership at the conference. It is our hope that the prize money will support the schools or school districts in any endeavor they feel is appropriate. However, LSBA would hope the dollars are used to promote ARTS Programs within their school(s).



**PLEASE NOTE:** A release is required from everyone featured in the video, as well as those involved in the production of the video. This authorization assures that those involved know that the video may be shown publicly without further consent required. There is no compensation for either appearing in or producing the video. (This release prerequisite is not necessary for crowd shots.) The release(s) must accompany both the submission form and video. It must be signed by the participant, and if the participant/student is a minor it must be signed by the student's parent/guardian. The school district submitting the video may use its district's standard release form for this purpose. Please be sure that the release covers internet usage. All entries must be in video DVD format, and once submitted the entrants grant to the contest organizers an irrevocable license to copy, edit, distribute, display and make other such uses as they wish at their discretion and in any format or medium. Keep in mind that all material must be original content created by the school. No copyrighted materials from outside sources will be allowed.
